The new Norgren system comprises four filter units. The first two stages of filtration remove carbon particles and oil droplets, preventing carbon blocking the after cooler and associated pipe work. The other two filters are a conventional water filter/separator and a coalescing filter installed after the main reservoir.

This new Norgren system is already being utilised by leading OEM's, and has produced significant improvements in particulate removal, leading to increased reliability.
